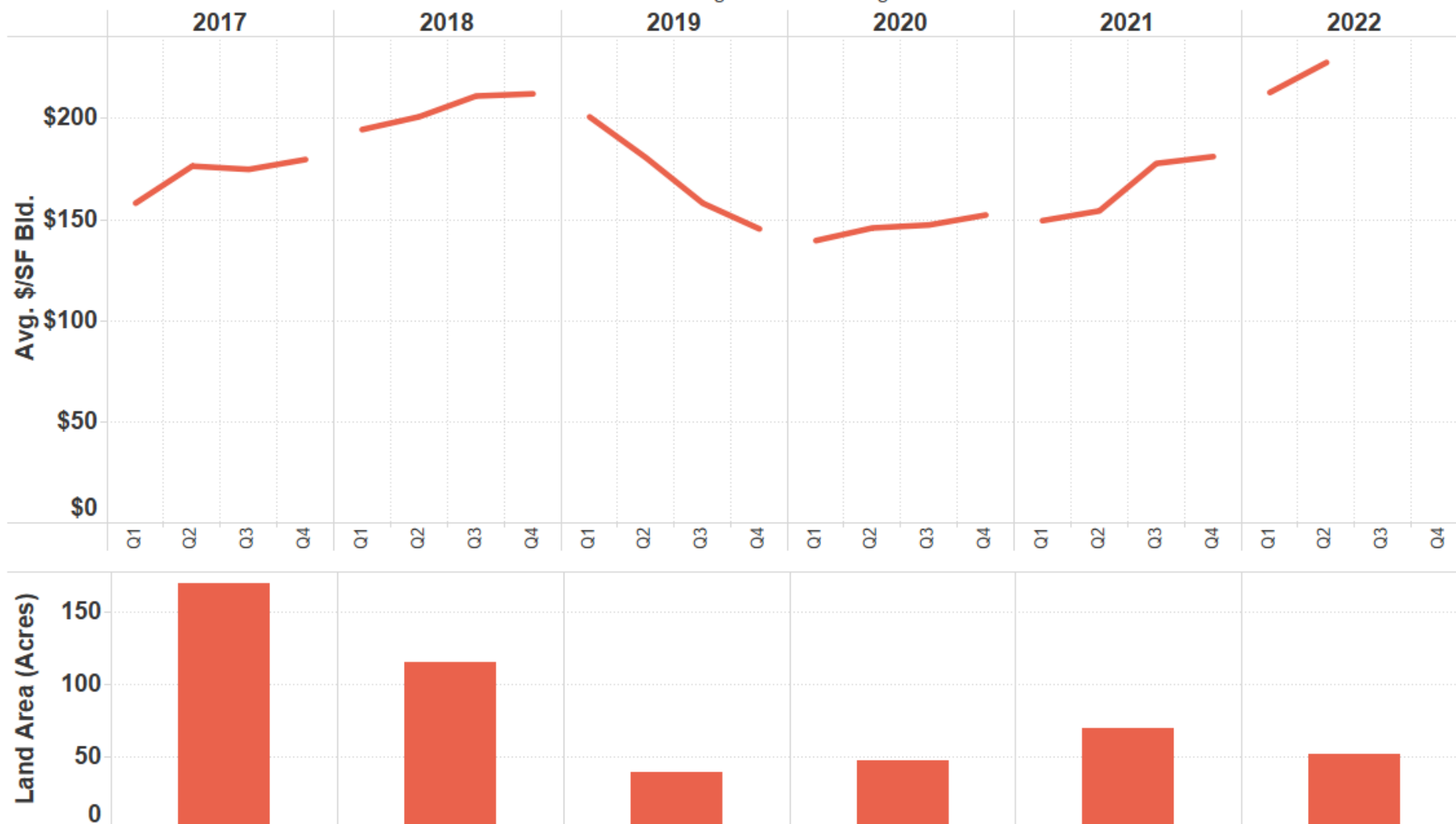






High Density Residential Land Transactions - Price (\$/SF Bld.) & Area (Ac.)

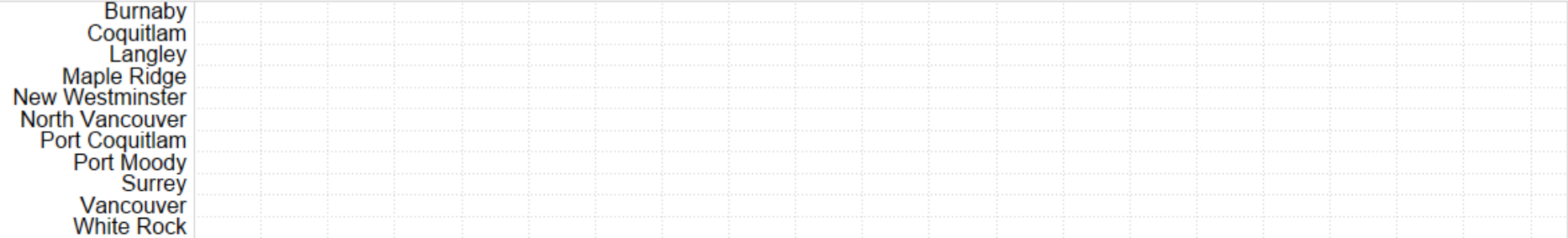
Greater Vancouver Area - Trailing 12 Month Average 2017 to Q2 2022



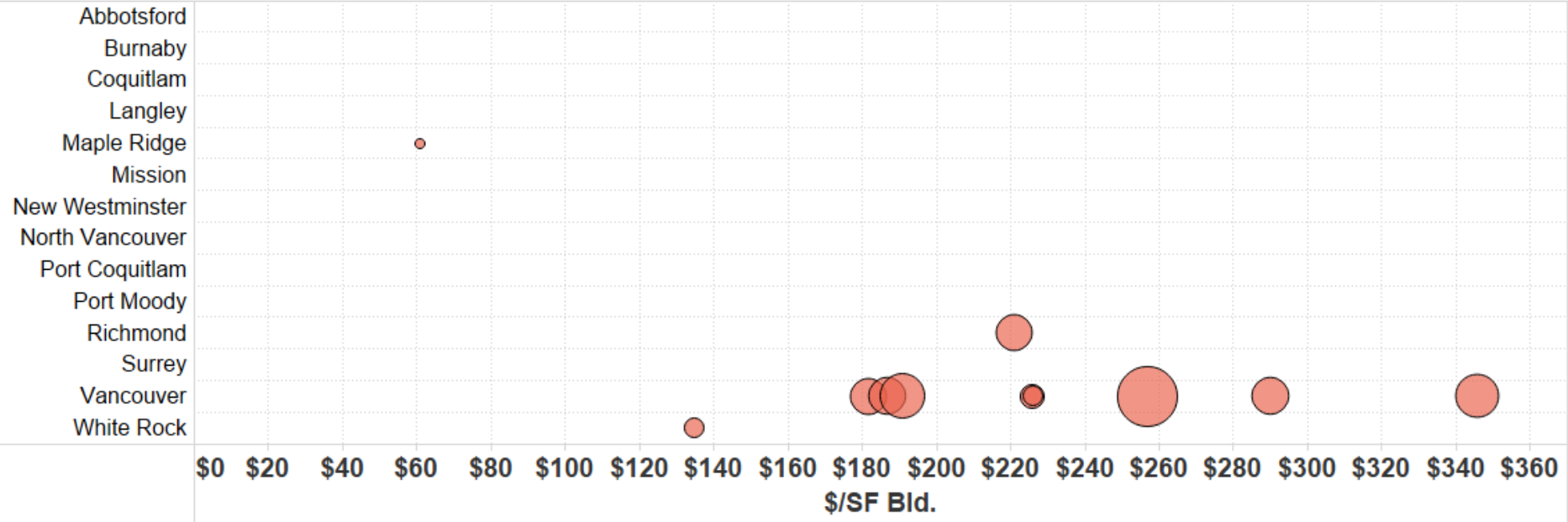
High Density Res. Land Transactions by Municipality & Price (\$/SF Bld.)

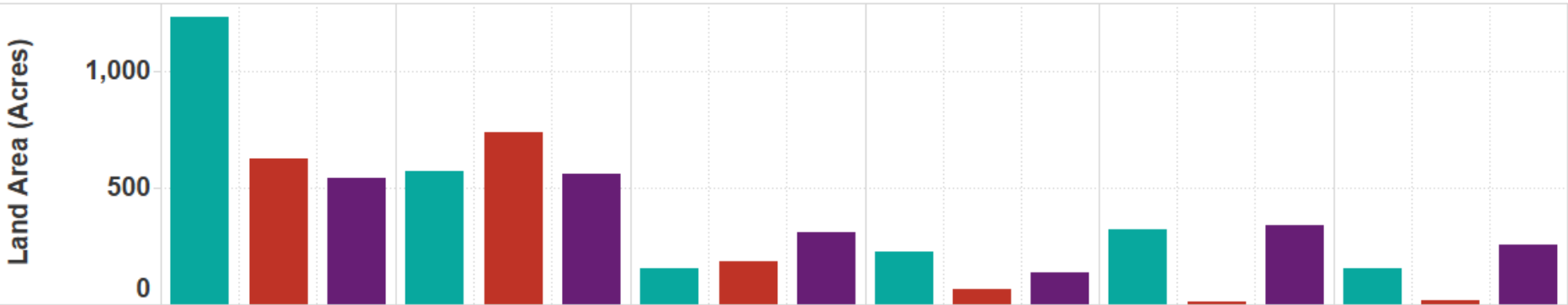

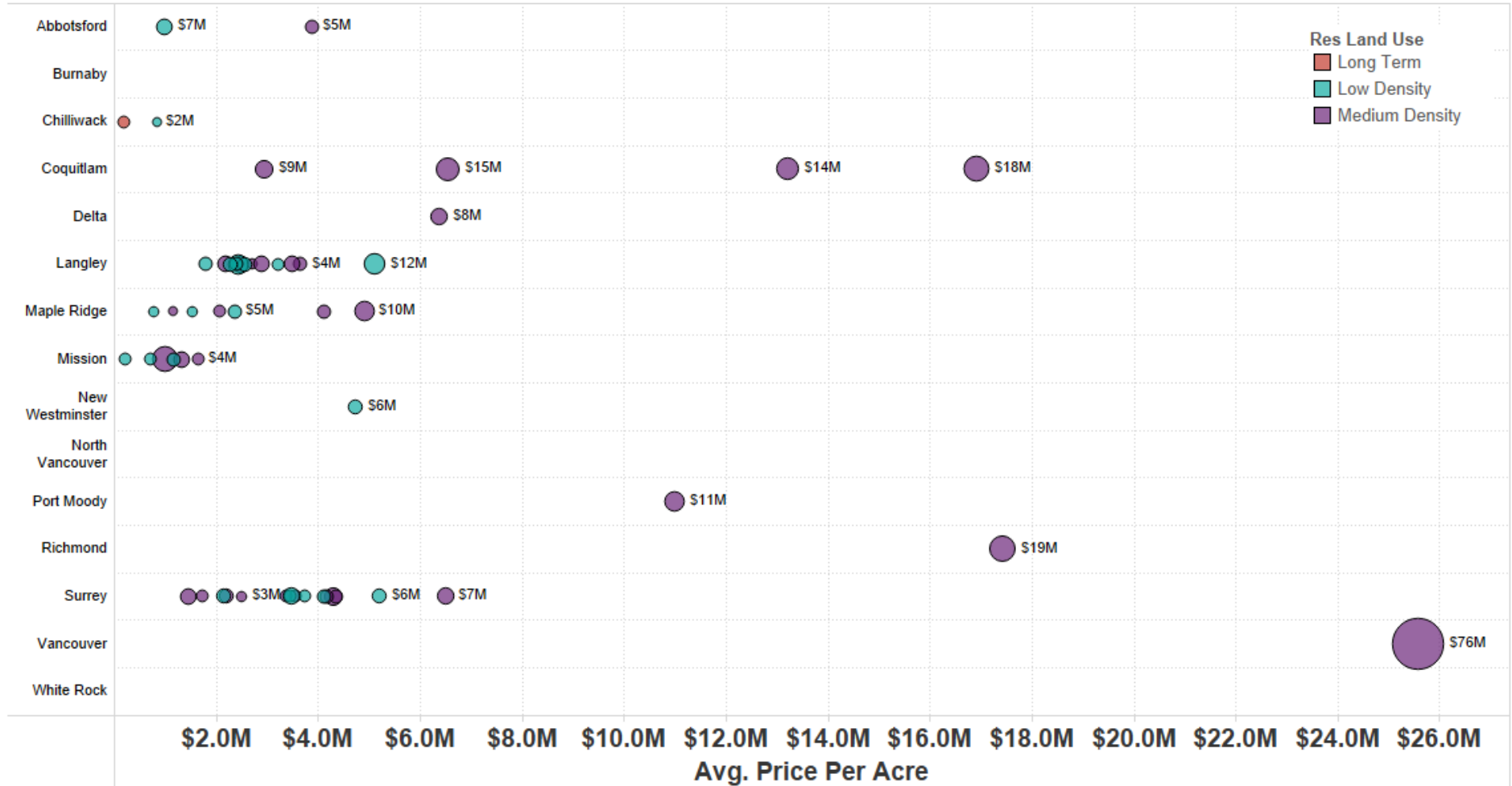


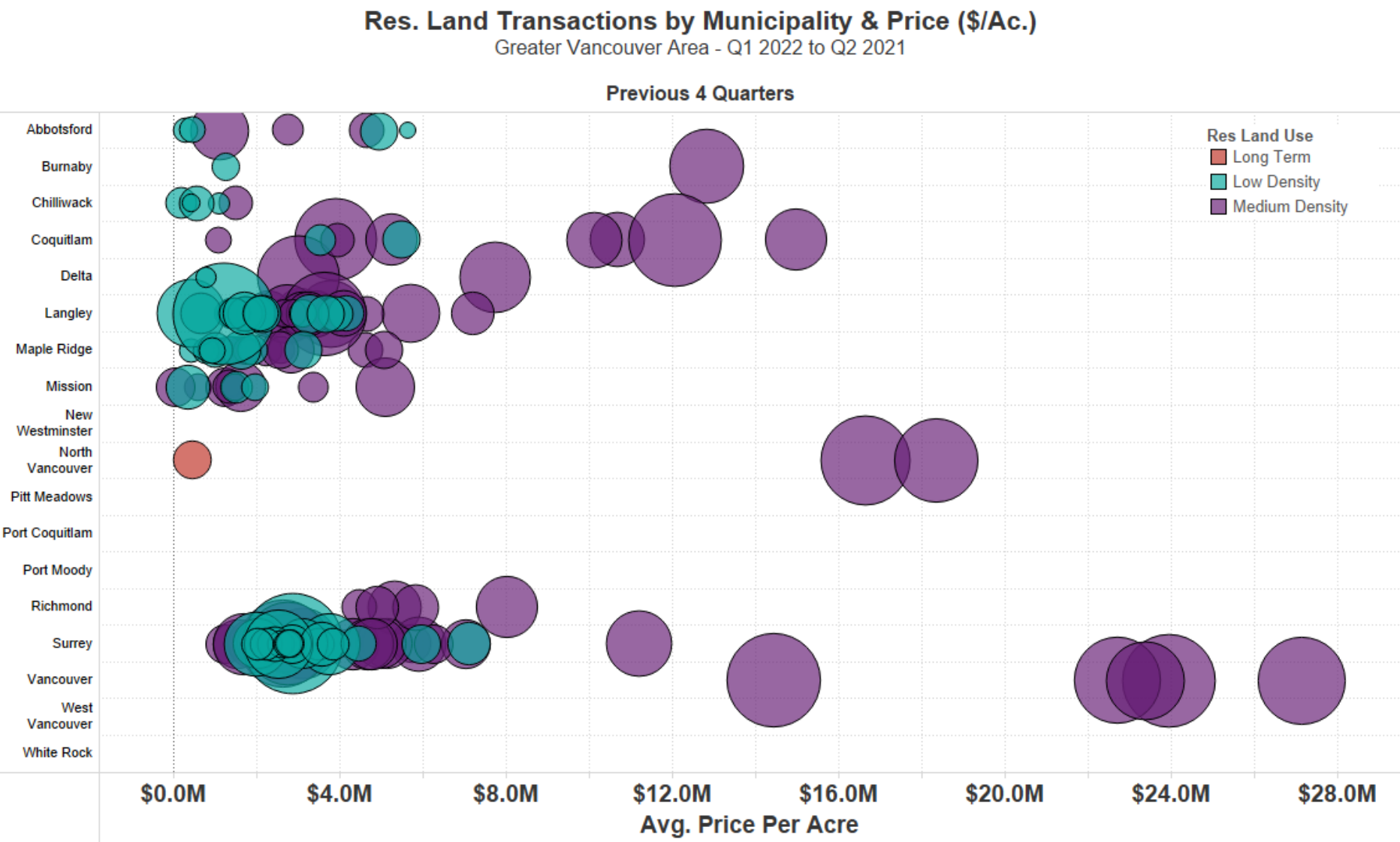
Residential Land Transactions - Price (\$/Ac.) & Area (Ac.) by Land Use

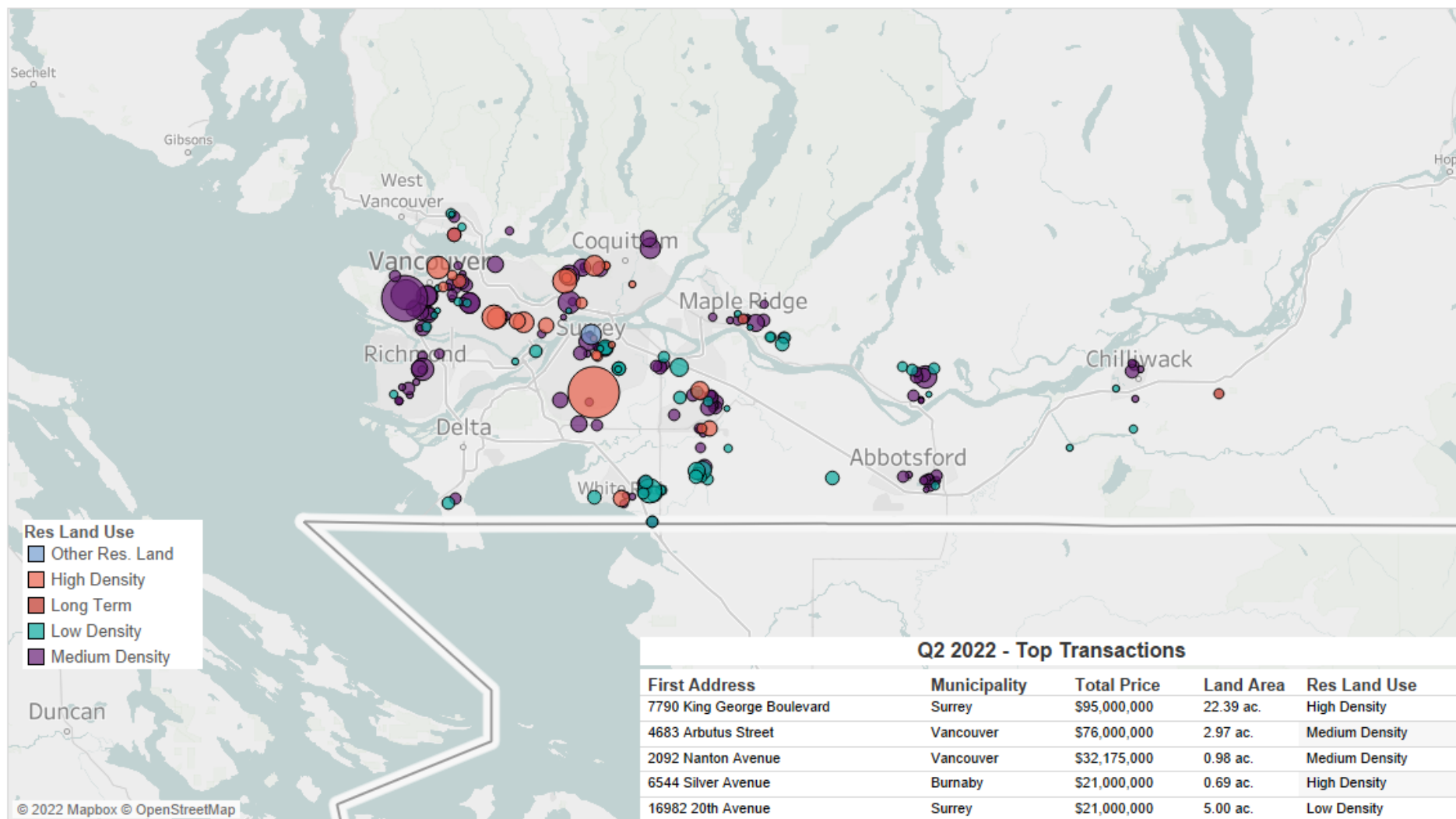
